AGRITECHNICA is now the world's leading trade fair for agricultural machinery!

AGRITECHNICA 2023 was attended by 2,897 exhibitors from 47 countries, including all the world market leaders.

Altogether 1,513 of these exhibitors came from outside Germany. The trade fair was divided into sector groups in 24 halls covering a floor space of over 100 acres and its nearly 200 forum events and specialist conferences allowed a unique exchange of information and opinions. The trade fair attracted around 450,000 visitors from 88 countries, including 106,700 international visitors.





November 10th, 2025

Day 1: Overnight flight from Canada to Hanover - Germany

November 11th, 2025

Day 2: Monday, November 11th 2025

Arrival Hanover airport from Canada – Wolfsburg (approx. 95 km)

Arrival at Hanover airport around noon from Canada. Our English speaking tour manager welcomes the group at the airport. Transfer to 4*-hotel "Alte Mühle Wolfsburg" in Wolfsburg.

Check in and time to relax after the long flight.

Dinner in hotel restaurant.

November 12th, 2025

Day 3: Tuesday, November 12th 2025

Wolfsburg – Hanover – Wolfsburg

Full buffet breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the fairground Hanover.

Visit to AGRITECHNICA, home of farming pioneers. All leading companies in the sector presents here every 2 years their new products and innovations at the world's leading trade fair for agricultural machinery. Agritechnica is the meeting place for decision-makers and the leading business marketplace. It is a showcase for the global agricultural engineering industry and a forum for the future of crop production. Lunch on your own at the fairground. Late afternoon back to Wolfsburg.

Dinner in a brewery restaurant.

November 13th, 2025

<u>Day 4: Wednesday, November 13th 2025 Wolfsburg – Hanover – Bremen</u>

Full buffet breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the fairground Hanover. Visit again to AGRITECHNICA. Late afternoon transfer towards Bremen.

Dinner and overnight in 4*-hotel "Radisson Blu Bremen" (B/-/D)





November 14th, 2025

Day 5: Thursday, November 14th 2025, Bremen

In the morning guided city walk through the old town of Bremen. You will see the famous town musicians as well as the impressive town hall, belonging to the UNESCO world heritage sites. You stroll along the river side and your guide will take you to the hidden small streets of the oldest quarter of Bremen, called Schnoor. Lunch in a typical Bavarian-style restaurant.

In the afternoon short walk (700 meters, 9 minutes). Visiting tour (3 hours) of Becks Brewery including small tasting.

Individually return to hotel dinner on your own tonight (approx. 1,2 km, 15 minutes). Overnight in Bremen. (B/L/-)

November 15th, 2025

Day 6: Friday, November 15th 2025 Bremen area

In the morning transfer to the "Seaport Brake" (25 km). The port is Germanys leader in the handling of grain and animal feed, but also in conventional general cargo handling. Europe's largest silo facility for grain and animal feed extends to the south of the port. You will visit the port and have lunch in the tower restaurant. Afterwards back to Bremen.

Visit of Mercedes Benz car facotory, lead plant for global production of the C-Class. From here, all C-Class production facilities are controlled, monitored and optimized. Note: Factory visit depending on availability. Can be can be requested at least 6 months before the appointment.

Farewell dinner in the historical "Ratskeller". Overnight in Bremen. (B/L/D)

November 16th, 2025

<u>Day 7: Saturday, November 16th 2025 Bremen – Barcelona, Spain</u> In the morning transfer to the airport for your flight to Barcelona Welcome to Barcelona

09h00 Start our tour of the Barcelona. During your guided tour of this beautiful city, you will see some of Gaudi's architectural works like the Basilica of the Sagrada Familia (inside visit), the Casa Mila (inside visit), and the Casa Batllo. All three buildings are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

12h00 Departure for the north part of the Catalonian region, Le Berguerà, area with many scenic and cultural attractions.

13h30 Lunch in a restaurant

15h00 Arrival to El Bergedà

Meeting with Federació Catalana de la Raça Bruna dels Pirineus and its Commercial manager, Mr. Martí Orriols Introduction to the Bruna dels Pirineus Beef Association

Visit to an important farm in the area The herds producing 'Ternera de los Pirineos Catalanes' or 'Vedella dels Pirineus Catalans' (Beef from the Catalan Pyrenees) basically comes from the Bruna Pyrenean breed, native to the area, resulting from a cross between the old native cow from the Catalan Pyrenean counties and the Alpine Brown breed. However, crosses with Charolaise and Limousine are allowed. It is a breed intended for beef production and with excellent milk production for rearing calves. They are a very rural breed, hardy in the fields. Their food is based on grazing, complemented by hay or forage at certain periods. The beasts are slaughtered at between 9 and 12 months for females and 10 and 15 months for males. The resulting product is a meat with tones ranging from pinkish to bright red, infiltrated with intramuscular fat. It is a high-quality, very tender and juicy meat.

09h00 Departure for Navás.

Les Navàs is one of the Catalan districts with the longest tradition in the production of olive oil. The extraordinary quality of this oil is the result of different factors: painstaking cultivation techniques, the climatic conditions of the area, with frequent mist and low rainfall, the use of varieties, the fact that the olives are picked directly from the tree using a system referred to as pentinat, and a completely cold production process.

10h00 We will visit an olive farm, where they will explain the different olive harvesting systems. We will continue with the visit to the olive oil production mill, emphasizing the production process and the machinery used for it. 11h30 Olive oil tasting

15h00 Visit to the facilities that Group Casacuberta has in the Parc d'Activitats Econòmiques d'Osona. After visiting all the dealer's facilities, explanation of the two solutions that currently exist in tractors to reduce particle emissions and comply with the European TIER 4A regulations: the SCR system of selective catalytic reduction, a system that uses urea, and the system CEGR for cooled exhaust gas recirculation. Then you can see the two systems on two tractors.

This Visit will allow reviewing topics of mechanics and maintenance of the tractor.
